

I was here with no purpose. I was just out there destroying my life."

Craig grew up without a father. His mother worked hard to provide for the family, but that meant Craig was often left alone.

To find company, he turned to the streets – but over the years, life went downhill. He began selling and using drugs, and fines and jail time followed. His family relationships struggled as well: "I tried not to be like my father and leave my kids, but I also didn't know how to be a man," he says.

Throughout his years of addiction, Craig also experienced homelessness, sometimes staying as an overnight shelter guest at our Market Street Mission – Jersey Shore location in Asbury Park.

Street life took a heavy toll on him, and he knew he needed to change. One day, he felt God telling him, "I'm going to give you another chance."

He went back to Jersey Shore – but this time, he decided to join our addiction recovery Life Change Program to find the healing he needed. "They showed me love and open arms," he says.

After completing the first program phase at Jersey

Shore, Craig transferred up to our Market Street Mission location in Morristown to participate in counseling and life-skills classes.

Our Learning Center was especially impactful: "Without drinking and drugs, I can focus better," he says. "I started from the third-grade level of everything and went up as far as I could."

With a renewed sense of hope, Craig is now learning that God has a purpose for his life.

"I'm trying to do the right thing, and I'm getting better every day," he says.

Now, he serves as a program intern at Jersey Shore, and he finds meaning in giving back.

"When I came to the Mission, I was addicted to drugs and had nowhere to go. Today, I'm an intern, and I just took my Certified Peer Recovery Specialist training. I am so blessed that I came to this program and God gave me a chance to get my life back. I have my family back today, and my grandkids – I'm so grateful."

Moving forward, our Jersey Shore Rescue Mission location in Asbury Park will be known as the Market Street Mission - Jersey Shore.

Why?

When the Market Street Mission in Morristown launched the Jersey Shore Rescue Mission (JSRM) in 2007, the board at Market Street wanted to localize this new Mission to make the most impact in the Shore community, and so gave it its own Jersey Shore brand identity. Despite its distinct name, JSRM has always been part of the Market Street family, using Market Street admin as well as core Market Street methods. Presenting as one unified Mission helps us better steward our donors' gifts. For the sake of familiarity and trust, our goal is to consistently identify all sites as part of the Market Street Mission family for the benefit of our overnight guests, clients and community relationships. For this reason, all our locations will share the Market Street Mission name and logo.

What will change?

Jersey Shore's services and care will remain exactly the same! Together, we will continue to provide meals, shelter, clothing and addiction recovery to our neighbors in need – just as we always have. Our Asbury Park thrift store will continue to offer clothing, furniture and other essentials at low prices as well. Jersey Shore's new name and logo will better reflect our identity as a cohesive Market Street Mission.

What about the lifeboat?

The "lifeboat of hope" in the Jersey Shore Rescue Mission logo represents the physical, emotional and spiritual care offered to our neighbors in need. While we are updating our logo to be consistent with Market Street as a whole, the lifeboat will always be at the heart of what we do together!
